- Committee resolution for criteria adopted to be signed by all members of committee compulsory
- Committee resolution for recommended list of students signed by all the members of the committee
- Acquaintance of merit-fellowship fund received by the student along with the photographs.

- Life & Health insurance fund:** The fund allocated under the special fee of admitted students to be insured for the admitted students and staff covering hospitalization, accident and death coverage with minimum payment premium of Rs. 100/- per student/staff.

Proof to be submitted:

- Copy of receipt of the payment
- Copies of the policy document along with the list of students insured

- Library & laboratory maintenance/upgrading fund:** The fund allocated under the special fee of admitted students to be utilized for upgrading/maintenance of existing labs/library. The utilization of fund to be incurred by the recommendation of the committee constituted for library & laboratory maintenance with the representation of management, principal and concerned staff members.

Proof to be submitted:

- Copy of the committee resolution recommendation.
- Total fund earmarked and used receipt for laboratory and/or library books/journals/e-journals/purchased.

- College development fund:** 5% of the total fee of total admitted students of the college in each academic year to be utilized for the college development. The utilization of fund to be incurred by the recommendation of the committee constituted for library & laboratory maintenance with the representation of management, principal and staff members.
