INTRODUCTION



INAUGURAL ADDRESS



The Chief Guest, Prof. Mokka Jagannadha Rao, Vice Chancellor, Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajamahendravaram

In his inaugural address observed that we had all been in lockdown for the past few months, living in fear and uncertainty, at war with an invisible enemy, with the normal life disturbed, economy affected, students, parents psychologically stressed, employees, daily wage workers and most importantly the farmers' incomes worst affected. Prof. Jagannadha Rao garu thanked the Commissioner Ms. Usha Kumari and especially the Additional Director, AYUSH, Dr. A. Purushotham garu for associating with the University for the Webinar. He was hopeful that a vaccine would be

developed at the earliest for us to get back to normalcy from this pandemic situation. Sir expressed his delight a webinar on such an important and valid theme was a highly commendable effort by the Department of Botany especially in collaboration with the Department of AYUSH, authenticates its purpose and mission. He was confident that the Indian Systems of medicine which stood the test of time could provide us solutions / interventions to contain and combat covid 19. The traditional systems of Indian medicine have been brought under the aegis of the Ministry of AYUSH an acronym for Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy, preserving and continuing this heritage to the future generation. The pandemic of Covid-19 has mobilised two most eminent scientific organizations of the country, CSIR & ICMR, to associate with Department of AYUSH, to study four herbal formulations used in Ayurveda, for their efficacy, therapeutic, pharmacological properties, as a pilot project. He urged the scientists from these systems of medicine to study the pandemic properties of the corona virus to help anticipate the dynamics of the future viruses. The deliberations on this platform, he hoped, would greatly be beneficial to all the participants.

Before concluding his speech, the Chief Guest, Prof. M. Jagannadha Rao garu, expressed his delight in having the Additional Director,AYUSH, Dr. A. Purushotham garu , as the Keynote speaker at this webinar. He acknowledged the participation of all the special invitees - Prof. Gonzalez from Mexico, Mr. Sridhar and Praveen from USA, Emeritus Prof. MNVS Prasad and all EC members, Principals and Deans of the University.

KEYNOTE ADDRESS



Additional Director, AYUSH, Dr. A. Purushotham

In his Keynote address, Sir, enumerated the activities of AYUSH under Health and Medical Family Welfare department, the key institutions under its affiliation and the medical camps in rural areas on health hygiene, pulse polio immunization, covid-19 containment etc. He presented a detailed account of the etymology of Corona virus in Covid 19, the rate and process of spread, the type of people worst affected; the symptoms of the disease and the intensity of infection, the types of tests available. Sir explained about the concept of genus epidemicus to use as Homoeopathic prophylaxis. A scientific advisory board of Ministry of AYUSH and CCRH (Central

Council for Research in Homoeopathy studied the symptomatology and pathogenesis of Covid-19, and it resembled the Arsenic Album genus epidemicus. Hence Government of India advised AYUSH the use of Ars.alb. in 30 pc as a prophylaxis for all Medical officers, ASHA workers and other frontline workers. Regarding the chemical research activity, he said, it is formidable to develop a vaccine as the genome of the virus is constantly changing its form making it difficult for a universal vaccine to be designed. Referring to the Ministry of AYUSH proposed protocols, he suggested a combination of AYUSH system with allopath. For scientific evidence, Government of India gave consent to CSIR and ICMR to associate with AYUSH to study the therapeutic properties of a few drugs used in Ayurveda. Active research is also been conducted in AYUSH institutes of Andhra Pradesh at Gudivada, Vijayawada and Tirupati. Sir announced that AYUSH Sanjeevani App is available for information to public on drugs available for containment of Covid-19.

Dr. Purushotham garu, patiently answered all the questions from the participants. The interaction proved very fruitful and satisfactory to the audience from their comments they posted in the chat box.

The Ayurveda practitioner, Dr. Venugopal Rao garu, explained the essence of his system of medicine by the statement:

SWASTHASYA SWASTHYA RAKSHANAM – ATURASHYA VIKAR PRASAMANAM - meaning -

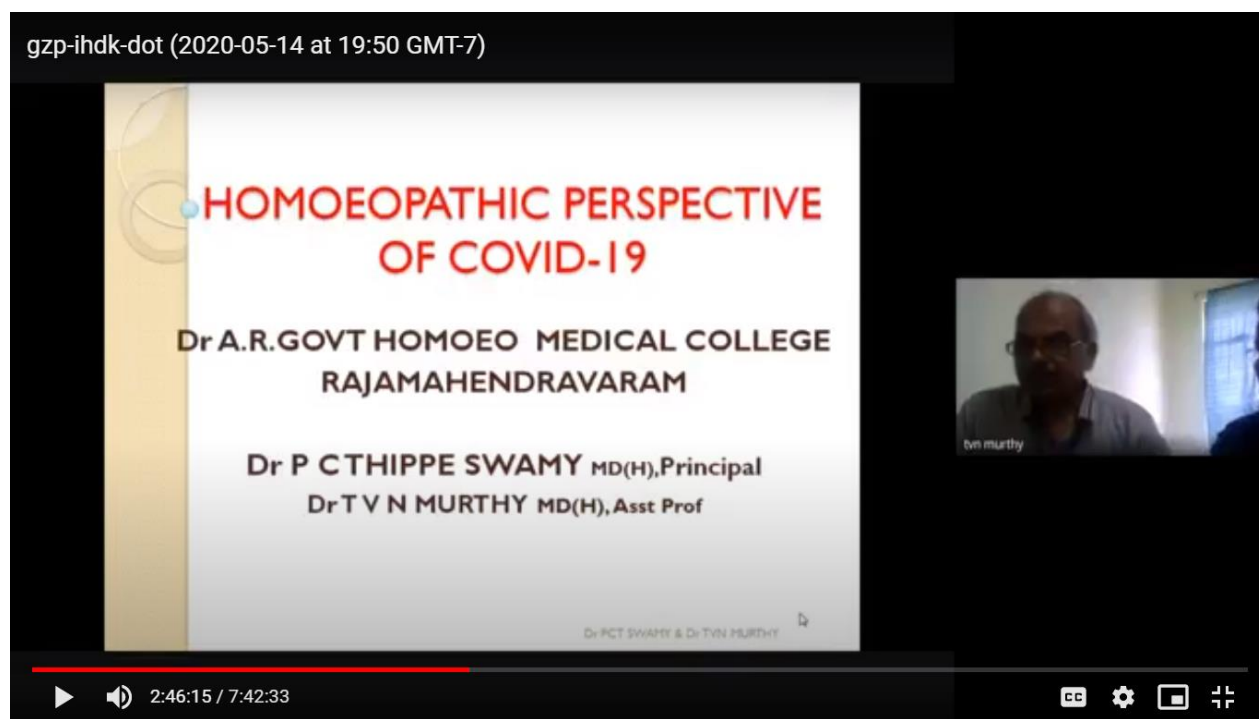
Prevention of Disease and Promotion of Health, which include : Dinacharya, Ratricharya, Ruthucharya, Rasayana, Vajikarana, Sadvritta and Yoga.

Nasya karma is used to treat the respiratory problems

Rasayana therapy helps prevent aging, improve longevity, strengthens immunity, and promotes mental competence, increases vitality and luster of body. He advised to avoid touching MEN, to escape Corona infection, M-Mouth, E-Eyes and N-Nose. Sir then explained about Corona virus- its genome, its infection behavior, symptoms, Incubation period, transmission and prevention.

He mentioned about the types of Vyadhi kshamatva- the immunity: Sahaja-age related; Kalaja-seasonal and Yuktikruta-artificial, and that 80% of cases are asymptomatic because of high immunity. He listed out a few immune-modulator drugs and practices and gave some medicinal combinations as home remedies, popularly known as AYUSH 64, as suggested by the ministry of Health. Sir concluded the session by compelling the participants to remember five things : 1. Hands-Wash; 2. Elbow-Sneeze/Cough; 3. Face-Donot touch MEN; 4. Feet-Stay 3 feet from each other; 5. Feel –sick –Stay Home.



As a resource person presented in many National and State level Health promoting programmes scheduled by Ministry of AYUSH like National Arogya Mela & Mother and child health programmes. Privileged to be a part of Public Health Initiative project on Control of malaria and Homoeopathic preventive distribution for COVID19.

Taking over from his Principal, Dr. TVN Murthy, presented the scientific evidences of the therapies in Homoeopathy, the clinical non pharmacological interventions and pharmacological interventions in

1. Treatment -antiviral, cortico-steroids and plasma therapy
2. Prevention – hydroxy chloroquine, Ars.alb

Efficacy of the vaccine is doubtful as 82 mutant strains of the virus have been identified. Relapse cases in S. Korea and China could be because of (i) Reinfection (ii) Reactivation – where the virus

replicates for an unusually long time (iii) False negatives – because of false test results / virus reach lower lung/intestine

Prophylaxis can be of different types: 1. Individual – where constitutional medicines based on mental status, appetite etc. elicit the drug. 2. Homoeo vaccination – in Cuba – April 2020, 1,84,000 people were administered combination drugs. 3. Nosodes – drugs prepared from diseased tissues/secretions – influenzinum and oscillococcinum 4. Genus epidemicus 5. Clinical similarities.

He expressed that a vaccine would prove expensive having adjuvant and preservatives with no age-dose discrimination whereas Homoeo prophylaxis would be cost effective with dynamic age-dose usage sans adjuvant and preservatives.

Two case studies from Agra and Gujarat were shown of success stories in Homoeo prophylaxis. In Andhra Pradesh also Ars.alb 30pc were administered 10 Lakh families, frontline workers, quarantined and old age groups through the MRO Office. Out of 2633 quarantined patients and 4935 target people no one turned +ve. He concludes by saying Homoeopathy is a time tested, cost effective, alternative for both treatment and control of pandemics like Covid-19 or others with unique holistic, host centered approach, boosting the immunity unlike agent centered approach of conventional medicine

Role of Naturopathy and Yoga in the Prophylaxis of Covid-19 Pandemic

Co – Convener, Ms. M. Prajna, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, introduced the Naturopathy and Yoga practitioner to the participants.

Dr. Sujana stated that Naturopathy and Yoga teaches you way of life, it is not treating with drugs. The food itself is medicine. A Naturopath treats the whole body, not just the symptoms. It is based on the theory of 'Unity of Disease and Unity of Cure. It works in modulating factors that improve body's innate healing properties by working on Psychological stress, Fitness, Physical activity, Nutrition, Sleep, Co-morbid conditions and lifestyle that shape the immune system.

Naturopathy interventions are used as adjunct preventive management. Treatment protocols address both physiological and psychological needs of the patient through : 1. Fasting 2. Diet therapy 3. Sunbath 4. Enema 5. Cold chest pack 6. Hotfoot and arm bath 7. Mustard chest pack 8. Asthma bath 9. Massage and Steam 10. Kriyas – the cleansing techniques: (i) Neti (ii) Dhouti (iii) Basti (iv) Nauli (v) Kapalbathi

Yoga interventions like 1. Asanas 2. Pranayama 3. Mudra and Meditation 4. Relaxation techniques 5. Karma Yoga 6. Bhakti yoga 7. Accupunture / accupressure 8. Aroma therapy 9. Sleep and most importantly preventive measures like (i) Wash hands (ii) Social distancing, (iii) Stay home (iv) Mask (v) Avoid touching face (vi) Eat well cooked food (vii) Do not spit.

She later explained some home remedies and yoga asanas to improve innate immunity for immune homoeostasis and symptom management.

CONCLUDING REMARKS



Prof. B. Ganga Rao, Registrar, Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajamahendravaram

Prof. Ganga Rao garu in his concluding address remarked on the knowledge shared by each resource persons and the information of the Etymology of Corona virus shared by the Guest of Honor Dr. Purushotham garu. He observed there were 45 lakh confirmed positive with 3 lakh deaths worldwide. India with 80,000 confirmed cases only 2000 deaths while in Andhra Pradesh out of 2,000 affected only 45 deaths. India being endowed with natural resources of diverse plants, animals, minerals and marine treasures, the different systems of medicine have also evolved utilizing this wealth. He deliberated on the different dispensaries and drug manufacturing

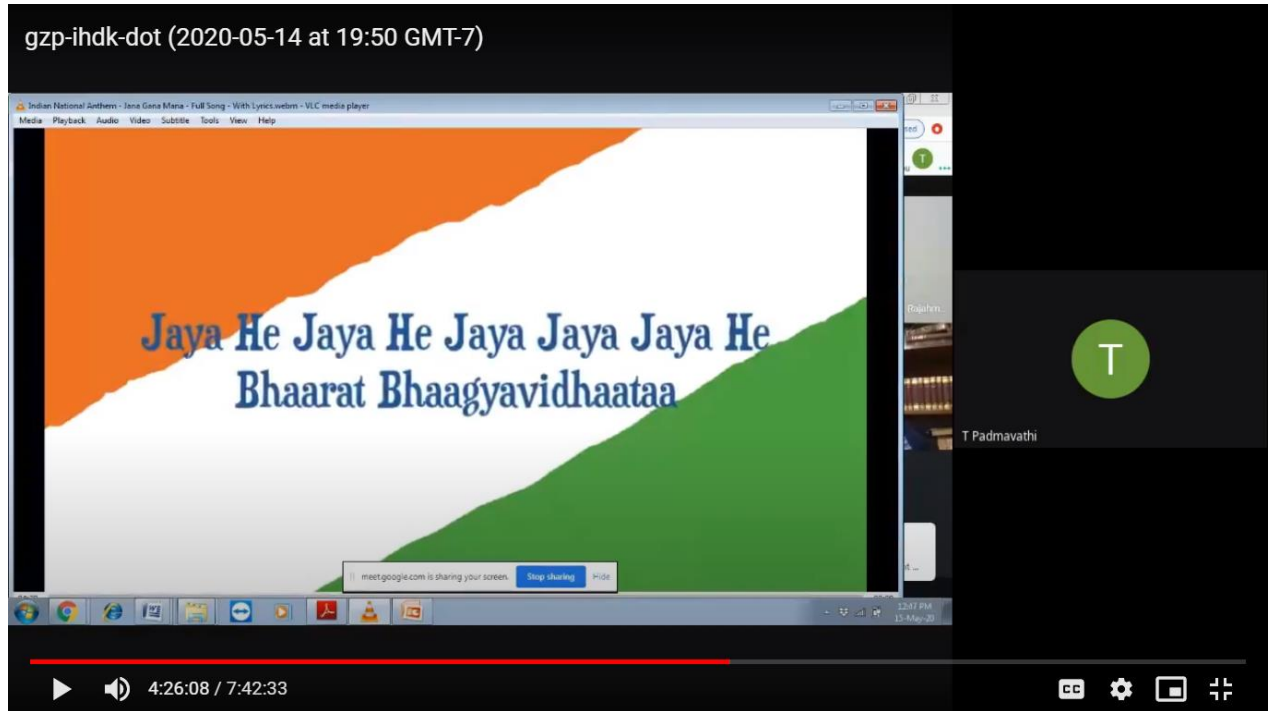
units for Ayurvedic formulations. He expressed his confidence that the prophylactic and treatment protocol suggested by the experts would undoubtedly contain Covid-19 in India.
